FY 2020 Budget Actions

The sum of the county's general fund operating budget plus its local education appropriation increased by 2.2% over the prior year. The property tax, a weighted rate, declined by \$0.0028. County provided general wage adjustments and service increments for all eligible employees. The county provided \$8.6 million more in education funding than the required maintenance of effort amount.
